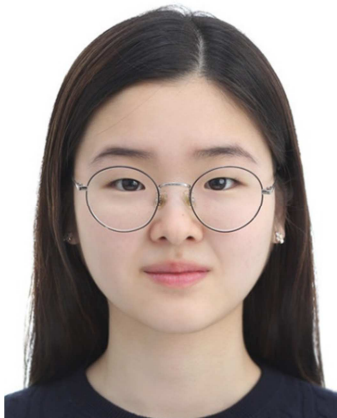


Differences in the benefits of music listening between South Korean teenagers studying in Korea and the United States: A pilot study report
